2. The CC would like to thank all brothers and sisters who took part in the **AGM last Sunday. All 5 voting motions were supported and passed** overwhelmingly by church members who were present and entitled to vote.
3. The CC have approved the following **2018/19 EC candidates** for election at the SGM next Sunday 13/5 from 4.15-5.00 pm: **Brian Siu, Michael Ho and Lawrence Woo**. Church members please endeavour to take part in the SGM but proxy form can be requested henceforth till 1.30pm next Sunday (13/5) either in person or by email from EC members. Completed proxy form **MUST** be returned to the EC by 2.00pm on 13/5.
4. The **May corporate prayer meeting** will take place **right after the SGM on 13/5** till 5.30pm. Let us all come together and pray in unity.
5. **Verse of the week:** *'Therefore he is able to save completely those who come to God through him, because he always lives to intercede for them.'* (Heb 7:25)
6. Pray for solutions to the ongoing threats of violence in **Afghanistan**. Pray for Afghans who are seeking the truth will come to know the Lord. Pray for protection over Afghan believers and perseverance despite sufferings. Pray for the work of World Vision which runs centres that provide remedial education for children and offer access to healthcare, proper nutrition, and counselling.
