3. 5. The EC has given a **brief report** on the **church finance** on the **back page of the bulletin**.
6. **Bible verse of the week: "When you fast, do not look somber as the hypocrites do, for they disfigure their faces to show others they are fasting. Truly I tell you, they have received their reward in full." (Matthew 6:16)**
7. We **thank God** for the **three sisters who were baptized** last week. May He **continue to strengthen their faith**. May they **follow the Lord Jesus Christ all their life**. Pray that they **be instruments for God and be witnesses of Jesus Christ**.

Pray also that the government willingly **accept religious beliefs and practices in China**.
12. The **US** went through its **mid-term election**, may God teach them to **put their hope in Him**, not on election result. May the Lord who never sleeps and always at work **bring forth renewal** among His people. May the election result in **restoration and reconciliation**.
